

PRIVACY POLICY
ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA RELATED TO PARKING

Sole proprietor **Mrs. Imréné Németh** (registration number: 57982780, registered office: 8380 Hévíz, Budai Nagy Antal u. 14.; tax number: 55668561140 – hereinafter: Data Controller), **as the data controller**, is committed to protecting the personal data of her clients. The Data Controller handles personal data confidentially and takes all necessary security, technical, and organizational measures to ensure the safety of the data.

The Data Controller provides parking services under the activity code 522102. This Data Protection Notice (hereinafter: Notice) provides information on the key aspects of personal data processing related to parking, in accordance with Article 13 of the GDPR.

Clients using the Data Controller's service	License plate number, time of arrival and departure, billing name, billing address, tax identification number, email address	In the case of the tax identification number, billing name, billing address, and license plate number: identification of the client and issuing the invoice. In the case of arrival and departure time: determination of the service fee. In the case of the email address: sending the invoice/e-receipt for the payment. The email address is forwarded to the Stripe payment service provider.	Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR (processing is necessary for the performance of a contract), and for billing data, also Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR (processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation), based on the provisions of Act CXXVII of 2007 on Value Added Tax.	8 years following the issuance of the invoice (according to Section 169(2) of Act C of 2000 on Accounting), or until the expiration of legal claims, if applicable.

Rights of the data subject:

The data subject may request information from the Data Controller regarding the processing of their personal data as described above, exercise their right of access to the data, request the rectification of their personal data, and—except in cases of mandatory data processing—request the erasure or restriction of processing. The data subject also has the right to data portability and the right to object.
